### **Match Funding**

Match funding is where a business, bank or company matches the amount you have raised. It is very common in large corporations. If you are fundraising, don't forget to ask your employer if they'll match your fundraising total, pound for pound.

We would be happy to recognise the match funding donor too. Please send us their details as we would love to thank them too.

**Gift Aid** 

GiftAid is a great way to boost your fundraising efforts without any additional work. GiftAid allows UK charities to reclaim an extra 25% in tax on every eligible donation made by a UK taxpayer.


Make sure you're encouraging your donors to claim it if they can. When making a payment or donation to you where a given amount is specified, you will have the option to document if they agree to GiftAid. This will be at no additional cost to the donor or you however to be eligible, the donor must have paid at least as much in Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax in that tax year as you want to claim in Gift Aid

#### A Breakdown of Charity Spending over the Last 12 Months


Our supporters help fund a huge range of projects and activities with 56p in every £1 going directly on these activities that have a direct impact on people with disabilities and their families across Essex and East London.



### Spend on Charitable Activities, Services & Events





### **Planning Your Event**

#### DATE, TIME & SETTING THE PLAN

What time of the year and day is best to suit your audience and things like the weather? What other events are going on in your area? Is it going to clash with an important date or another event locally or nationally? Remember to give yourself plenty of time to plan and get everything together. A planner/diary can be really helpful from day 1.

### WHERE TO RUN THE EVENT?

Finding a venue if required can sometimes be the most challenging bit, however, use local contacts, friends and family to help. Ensure the space is suitable and look at your number limits. If stuck, speak to your local council or churches for community halls and venues. Is there suitable parking, transport links and access for people too? And remember **BOOK EARLY!** 

#### PROMOTING YOUR EVENT

Get anyone and everyone you know to publicise what you're doing! Use Facebook and other social media, and contact your local radio station or paper. These are quick, simple and effective ways of promoting events at little or no cost. If you need help, contact us as we can also help with flyers, posters and social media.

#### **GETTING HELP**

It's important to get help early. Ask your contacts in work, schools, businesses, churches etc to help you promote the event and see if anyone wants to volunteer. A great way to increase your fundraising is to ask your employer if they will match-fund. For every £1 you raise, they give you £1 easy! Also, lots of local businesses are often happy to donate prizes for raffles for a little advertisement.



#### WHAT DO YOU NEED?

Planning early and getting things ready really helps. Speaking with local businesses for support should happen early to give them time to help you. It's important to remember health & safety and licencing too. Some events may need approval from your local council so just check first. Some venues already have this so it may not be needed.




